Your PERA Benefits

State Trooper Provisions

February 2009

As a State Trooper (or CBI agent), your benefits are the same as explained in *Your PERA Benefits*, except for the following:

PERA Membership and Contributions

As a PERA member, you contribute 10.0 percent of your salary to the Fund. Your employer contributes a total of 15.65 percent of its total trooper payroll to PERA. Of this amount, 1.02 percent is deposited in the Health Care Trust Fund, 1.80 percent is designated as the Amortization Equalization Disbursement (AED), and 1.00 percent is designated as the Supplemental Amortization Equalization Disbursement (SAED).

As a State Trooper, you are eligible to apply for disability retirement benefits immediately if your disability is sustained during the performance of your duties. The maximum

benefit is 50 percent of your Highest Average Salary (HAS), unless you have more than 20 years of actual service, in which case you will receive an additional 2.5 percent for each year over 20.

Purchasing Service Credit

The cost to purchase service credit is the actuarial cost of providing the future benefit and is based on your age at the time of purchase. See the *Purchasing Service Credit* booklet or the PERA Web site at www.copera.org for the cost to purchase.

Retirement Benefits

You may apply to receive a monthly retirement benefit after you have met the age and service credit requirements. Your benefit is based on your years of PERA service credit, age, and HAS. See the Retirement Benefits and Benefit Options information in the *Your PERA Benefits* brochure.

Service Retirement

You will qualify for a service retirement benefit if you meet the following requirements:

Minimum Service Credit	Minimum Age
30 Years	Any Age
25 Years	50
20 Years	55
5 Years	65

Reduced Service Retirement

If you meet the following requirements, you may retire earlier with a reduced benefit:

Minimum Service Credit	Minimum Age
20 Years	50
5 Years	60

Highest Average Salary Percentages

Percentages shown on the chart on the opposite page are for Option 1 retirement selection (see the Benefit Options information in the *Your PERA Benefits* booklet). Final calculations are made to the exact amount of service you accrue; you earn credit for each month that you work.
