The chart below shows how the money in your Hartford Defined Contribution (DC) plan will automatically be transferred into PERA's DC Plan (or 401(k) Plan for any rollover money). Please review the new Plan investments and decide how this change will affect your investment portfolio. If you wish to change your investments prior to the transition, you must do so before Tuesday, June 23 at 2:00 p.m. as you will not be able to make changes during the blackout period. If you would like to change these investments after the blackout period, you may do so by logging on to PERA's Web site at www.copera.org or by calling PERA at 1-800-759-7372 and selecting the 401(k)/DC Plan option.

SEI Stable Value Fund

Assets in the SEI Stable Value Fund may be transferred to PERA by Hartford. Hartford reserves the right not to transfer the money in the SEI Stable Value Fund to PERA and keep the money until 2010 in the event SEI places a hold on the fund pursuant to the prospectus. At this time SEI is not imposing the hold period. At such time as the money in the SEI Stable Value Fund is transferred, PERA will place the money in the PIMCO Low Duration Fund. If you wish to have guaranteed access to the money you currently have invested in the SEI Stable Value Fund, you must transfer your money out of the SEI Stable Value Fund prior to June 23 into one of the other funds available in your Hartford investment line-up.
