Andrew is the Deputy Director for the Teacher Retirement System of Texas (TRS), the sixth-largest public pension fund in the US with assets under management of over \$185 billion. TRS provides retirement security for over 2 million members and health care for some 750,000 members, their spouses, and dependents. He oversees Finance, Health Care, Benefit Services, Information Security, Business Administration, Organizational Excellence (HR), and Information Technology.

Previously, Andrew served as the Benefits and Services Executive Offer (BSEO) at the California State Teachers Retirement System (CalSTRS); prior to that, he was the Director of Retirement Readiness at CalSTRS. Other experience includes serving as the Director of Education and Outreach for the California state securities regulator, a Public Information Officer for the California Department of Social Services, and as an auditor for the California Bureau of State Audits. Andrew received the North American Securities Administrators Association's Distinguished Service Award for his contributions to investor protection.
